

## Greater Manassas Veterans Day Parade Participant Instructions

**All participants should arrive between 9:00 AM and no later than 10:15 AM.  
The parade steps off at 11:00 AM SHARP!**

The Parade line of march will be posted on our website [www.vetpar.org](http://www.vetpar.org) and attached to these instructions

Please confirm Division and position number and insure your marchers have this information this will aid marshals in directing them to staging location.

**NO** vehicles other than those in parade will be allowed to enter staging area, *except local residents*

Please insure you use designated entry location for your Division & Unit.

**There is no parking near or in the staging area.** Please refer to the Map of municipal parking lots. Manassas City Hall is closest Municipal lot to staging area

**ALL Participants** are reminded to follow instructions of division parade marshals and to keep the parade moving.

- Please refrain from stopping and performing along the parade route as this causes unnecessary breaks and delays in the parade.
- Everyone is reminded not to throw any items towards the crowds. If you are giving away anything do not throw it but give it directly to spectators.
- The parade will pause for the Grand Marshals to exit vehicles and take place of honor on the stage.
- There will be presentation of Colors and singing of National Anthem immediately after Grand Marshals take place of honor – Please remain silent and pay proper respect during this time. Marshals will inform you when it is clear to resume parade activities.

While staging please keep center of Quarry Rd. clear to allow movement of units to proper position in the parade.

Parade marshals will be assigned to each of the divisions in the parade and will be available to answer questions and assist as needed they will be wearing Green Vest.

Additional parade marshals will be along the parade route and will provide assistance as needed.

We will have information tables at City Hall and corner of Quarry Rd. and Prescott Ave. to provide assistance to anyone not sure where their unit is in the parade

# Greater Manassas Veterans Day Parade Participant Instructions

All participants will disperse at the municipal parking lot located between Center & Church Street (behind the 7-Eleven). Some participants may be directed to use the municipal lot near the Harris Pavilion to give them time to break down their floats or other special needs. Please follow the instructions of the parade marshals and Police officers directing traffic. No floats will be permitted to exit dispersal area unless all objects and persons are secure

## STAGING AREA

**Participants in Division A & E** will stage on Quarry Road near Seton HS. Please enter staging area from Zebedee Street (Quarry Road will be closed from Maple St. to Prescott Ave.) A marshal will be available to allow access.

**Division A** will form up at intersection of Quarry Rd and Prescott Ave continuing back on the right side of the road towards Maple St.

**Division E** will form up starting at intersection of Maple St and Quarry Rd. (behind Division A)

**Participants in Divisions B, C & D** are to enter Quarry Rd from Euclid Ave. Parade marshals will be available to provide assistance.

### **There is no access for vehicles from Prescott Ave onto Quarry Rd.**

Short term parking for drop off is available at Payne Publishing. After dropping off at Payne Publishing please move vehicles to municipal parking available in Old Town Manassas.

**Division B** will form starting at Prescott Ave and continuing back on Quarry Road to the 3 way stop sign. Please follow Marshals Instructions and keep the left side of road clear.

**Division C** will form on the RIGHT side of Quarry Road starting at the 3 Way stop sign and continuing back towards Litho Lane. (adjacent to Assisted living home)

**Division D** will form on LEFT side of Quarry Road from 3 way stop sign back towards Litho Lane. Please keep center of Quarry Road clear
